

We wish all our guests beautiful competition days, the achievement of your self-set goals, and a pleasant stay.



Location sketch Saturday



WRE	The M/W 21 classes in the Federal Ranking Long Distance event on Saturday will be conducted as a World Ranking Event (WRE). The expected winning times in the W21 category are between 70-80 minutes, and in the M21 category, they are between 90-100 minutes. The start lists for these classes will be built based on WRE points.						
Starting number WRE	Will be provided for the elite classes on Saturday. They can be picked up at the event office on Saturday. The starting numbers must be worn visibly on the upper body.						
Warm-Up Map	It can be picked up at the organization office. The start of the warm-up course is on the way to the start and is marked on the terrain.






Caution

Rock Wall: In the terrain, there is a rock wall in the final part of the course that can be easily overlooked from above, and it is very steep and dangerous. For this reason, this area is marked as a restricted zone and is marked in the terrain with barrier tape.


